Notice is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Sherman, Chautauqua County, New York, at a regular meeting thereof, held on February 4, 2021, duly adopted, subject to a permissive referendum, a resolution, an abstract of which is as follows:

***RESOLUTION TO REDUCE NUMBER OF
TOWN JUSTICES FROM TWO TO ONE***

- 1. The number of town justices of the Town of Sherman shall be reduced from two to one, with the unfilled office of Town Justice Douglas Neal being abolished, effective January 1, 2022; and*

- 2. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of section 60-a of the Town Law, this resolution shall not become operative or effective unless and until thirty days have elapsed after its adoption and no petition protesting against this resolution signed and authenticated as required by law has been filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Sherman, or if such petition is so filed, a proposition for approval of this resolution has been submitted at the next general election or a special election for that purpose pursuant to said section and received the affirmative vote of a majority of the voters voting thereon.*
