Thank you **Triple E Manufacturing** for donating masks to the Village of Sherman employees.

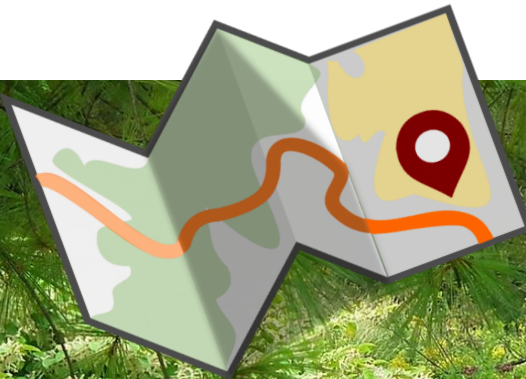
Triple E Manufacturing masks can be purchased at our Sherman Area Pharmacy.
